Please allow me to give you an update on what our church has done to help the earthquake victims in Haiti.

To date we have given \$13,455 directly to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) to aid their relief efforts in Haiti. When we give through UMCOR, 100% of our giving goes directly to relief efforts because all administrative costs are covered by our denomination's annual One Great Hour of Sharing Offering which we will be taking up this year on March 14.

In addition to our monetary donations, we supplied UMCOR with 446 health kits to be used in Haiti. Thanks to all of you who put together health kits and thanks especially to those of you who got you neighborhoods and places of work involved in our health kit drive as well.

Every health kit contained within it \$5 for shipping. Thanks to the opportunity to ship our kits along with other kits from United Methodist Churches in the Holston Conference our total shipping per kits came out to \$2 per kit rather than the \$5 we first anticipated. This left us with \$1,916 left over to send to UMCOR to be used to in their Haiti Relief efforts. (This \$1,916 is included in the above total of \$13,455 given by our church to UMCOR for relief efforts in Haiti.)

Now consider this: when you combine our gifts to Haiti with the gifts of all the other 903 United Methodist Churches in the Holston Conference (which encompasses East Tennessee and Southwestern Virginia) the numbers are staggering. The United Methodist churches of the Holston Conference together have now given over \$590,000 and collected over 17,000 health kits to be used for relief efforts in Haiti.

I'm proud that Middlebrook Pike's ministry in Haiti will not end with monetary donations and health kits. In August, we will be sending a mission team comprised primarily of young adults to Haiti. The team will be led by our youth and young adult director,

Eric Bronkala. In their attempt to raise prayers and funds for their trip to Haiti, the mission is sponsoring a worship event called *A Heart for Haiti* here at our church on the evening of Saturday May 8. The evening will feature the music of Casey Darnell who has led worship for the past two years at Divine Rhythm, the Holston Conference Young Adult Worship Retreat, and the preaching of Justin Lookadoo, who has been the preacher for the last two years at Resurrection, the Holston Conference Youth Worship Retreat. Tickets for the event have already gone on sale and we have begun inviting churches from around the Holston Conference to the event. I believe the event will be a blessing to everyone who attends and to our Haiti Mission team. Even as we continue to seek to support the people of during this critical time, we have all been saddened to learn of the powerful earthquake that hit the nation of Chile on Saturday February 27. Initial reports already confirm over 700 people have perished as a result of the quake. UMCOR is already working to provide relief in Chile while continuing its relief efforts in Haiti.
